POSITION SUMMARY

This position reports to the Meter Section Supervisor and performs semi-skilled labor by walking or driving along established routes to read and record the consumption of water through handheld devices for residential and commercial meters and works directly with customers.

The ideal candidate will be a motivated individual with sound judgement who can work and drive in all weather conditions, works independently and as part of team, troubleshoot and problem solve, shows initiative, has effective verbal and written communication skills, and works safely while maintaining a high level of organization, accountability, and attention to detail.

POSITION REQUIRES



- A high school diploma or general education degree (GED).
- A minimum of six (6) months of work experience directly related to the position, such as construction, plumbing, electrical, concrete, etc.
- A valid Colorado driver license and insurability under District insurance standards. Completes required driver training and obtains a Class A CDL with air brakes within one (1) year from the date of hire into the position.
- Training in flagger, trenching and excavation, confined space, forklift, and CPR/First Aid.
- A 40-hour work week, works overtime, and responds to emergencies when required.
- Working on-call shifts as needed.
