INVITATION TO BID

The Ute Water Conservancy District will **receive sealed bids** at the Administration Office located at 2190 H 1/4 Rd, Grand Junction, Colorado 81505, **until 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, September 16, 2022**, for the **COLORADO RIVER PRE-SEDIMENTATION FACILITIES PROJECT**.

The project contemplated consists of the construction of two earthen pre-sedimentation ponds with concrete lining, 24-inch piping, concrete outlet structures, associated process and electrical equipment including connection to existing 24-inch discharge pipeline and other miscellaneous work as described in the Contract Documents.

Plans, specifications and bid documents may be reviewed at the Ute Water Administration Office. The Contract Documents for this project may be obtained online at our website (<http://www.utewater.org/projects.html>) at no cost. Downloads include the project specific specifications and accompanying full-scale drawings.

A mandatory Statement of Interest is required via email to [dpriske@utewater.org](mailto:dpriske@utewater.org) by 5:00 pm on **Friday, August 19, 2022**. **Pre-bid meetings** will be scheduled with interested bidders by appointment on **Wednesday, August 24, and/or Thursday, August 25, 2022** at the Owner's water treatment plant off of Rapid Creek Road, northeast of Palisade, Colorado. Attendance **is** mandatory.

Ute Water's office will stamp the date and mark the time received on all bids. Bids received after the date and time indicated on the Invitation to Bid will not be considered. The Ute Water Conservancy District is not responsible for delays occasioned by the US Postal Service, or any other means of delivery employed by Bidder. A public Bid opening will not take place, the selected Bidder will be notified no later than **September 30, 2022**. If agreement terms can be arranged between the selected Bidder and Owner, all other Bidders will be notified no later than **October 7, 2022**.

A five percent (5%) Bid Bond **will** be required, as well as one hundred percent (100%) Performance and Payment Bonds to guarantee the faithful performance of the contract. It is required that the surety issuing such bonds have an attorney-in-fact or a principal doing business in Colorado. This information must be included on the bond statement.

The Ute Water Conservancy District reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to postpone the award for thirty (30) days, to delete certain items from the Proposal, and to award the Contract to the lowest responsible bidder.

The Ute Water Conservancy District may reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed bidding procedures and requirements and, may reject any and all bids upon finding that it is in the District's best interest to do so.

Contractor shall be licensed as required by the State of Colorado and local governments or municipalities.
