

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Ute Water Conservancy District (“District”) hereby gives notice that the term of office for five directors of the District will expire on May 10, 2026. The directors whose terms are expiring are from the following subdivisions of the District: one director from Subdivision No. 1, one director from Subdivision No. 2, one director from Subdivision No. 3, one director from Subdivision No. 4, and one director from Subdivision No. 5.

The District further gives notice that applications for appointment as a director from Subdivisions No. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 will be accepted by the Mesa County District Court until April 10, 2026. Application forms may be obtained at the District office, 2190 H 1/4 Road, Grand Junction, CO 81505, or on the District’s website (www.utewater.org). Completed applications may be mailed to the Mesa County District Court, P.O. Box 20,000-5030, Grand Junction, CO 81502, or delivered to the Mesa County District Court, 125 N. Spruce Street, Grand Junction, Colorado. Please also send a copy of any application to the District’s General Counsel by email to: chrisg@balcombgreen.com.

An applicant for director from the subdivision whose director’s term is expiring or vacant must live in and be the owner of real property within that subdivision, must have resided within the District boundaries for a period of not less than one year, and must have a background reflecting agricultural, municipal, industrial, or other interests in the beneficial use of water and water matters within the District.

The boundaries of Subdivisions 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of the District are described as follows:

Subdivision No. 1: that territory within the District bounded on the west by the centerline of 30 Road, north of the Colorado River, and also bounded on the west by the centerline of 29 Road, south of the Colorado River.

Subdivision No. 2: that territory within the District north of the Colorado River bounded on the west by the centerline of 23 Road and bounded on the east by the centerline of 30 Road.

Subdivision 3: that territory within the District north of the Colorado River bounded on the west by the Colorado State and Utah State line and bounded on the east by the centerline of 23 Road.

Subdivision No. 4: that territory within the District south of the Colorado River bounded on the west by the Gunnison River and bounded on the east by the centerline of 29 Road.

Subdivision 5: that territory within the District which is south of the Colorado River and west of the Gunnison River, generally known as “The Redlands.”
